



NODA Awards Policy

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Introduction

The society is often fortunate to be nominated for awards, usually by NODA, and we often are limited to how many members may attend. This policy was created to ensure that attendance is managed fairly.

Where a Production has been Nominated

The director, choreographer, musical director, and stage manager have first refusal on tickets. If other tickets are available, they should be offered to the cast and crew without bias for their role.

Where an Individual has been Nominated

The individual may decide who to invite and give their tickets to. Whilst the society would recommend that they be given to members of the production, there is no obligation to do so and the member may be given to family and friends.

Where a Child has been Nominated

The child must be accompanied by their parent or guardian.
